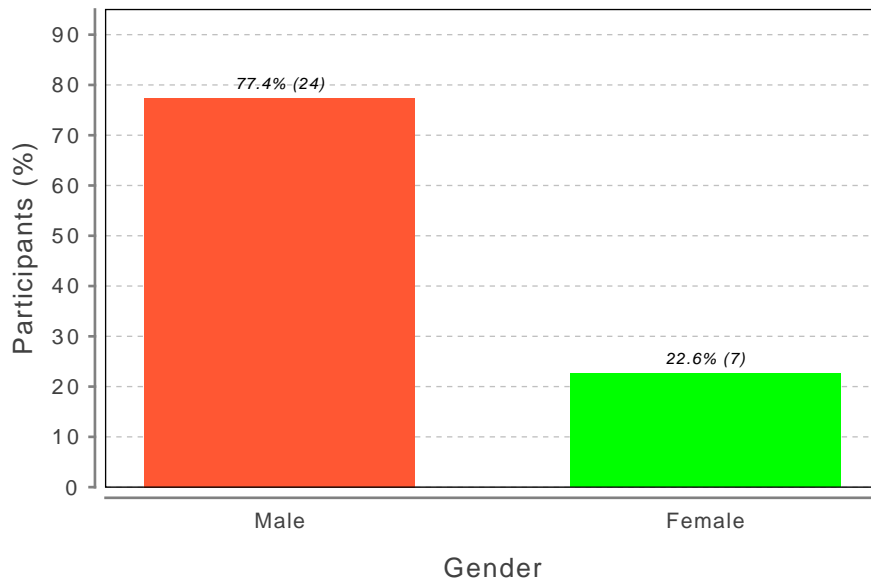

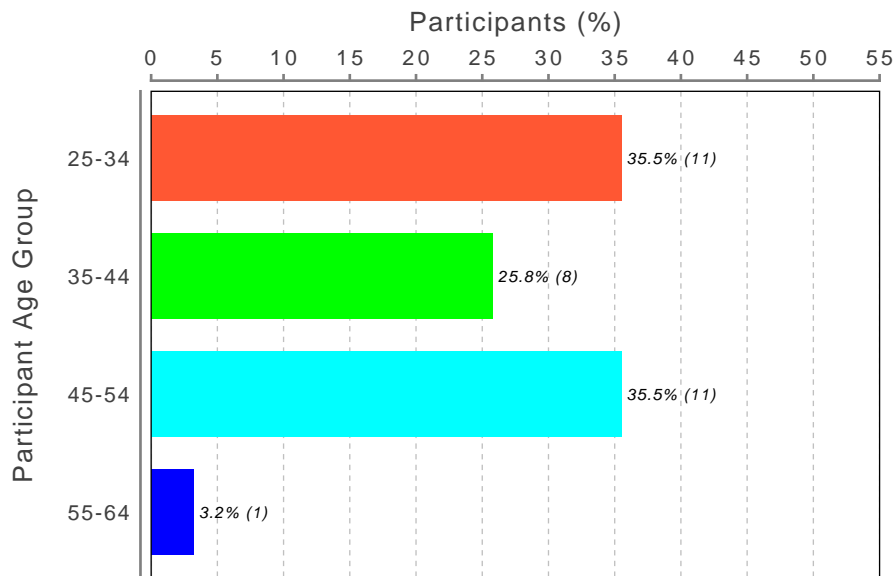

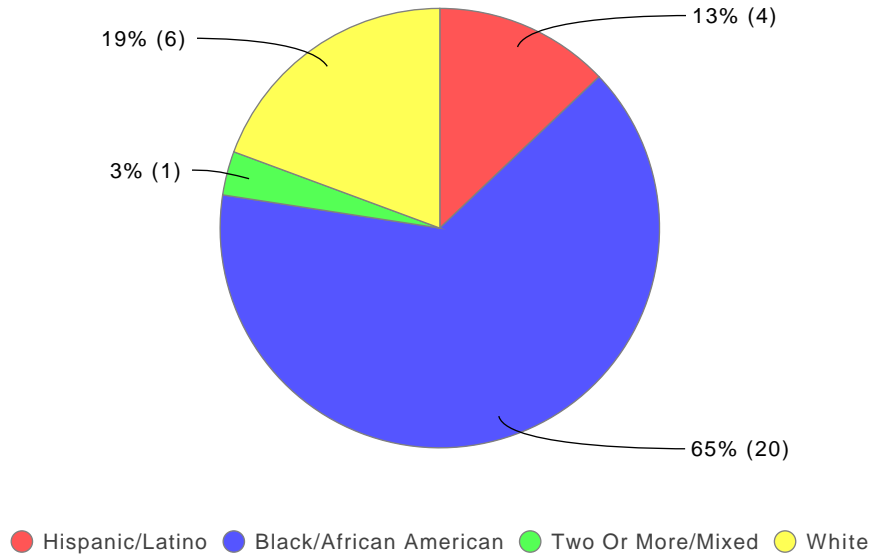

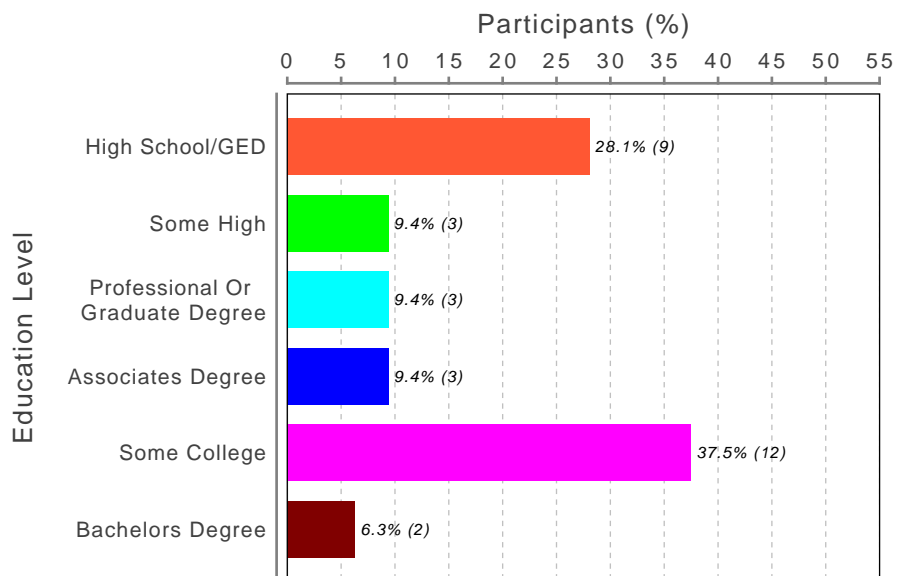
Participant Race

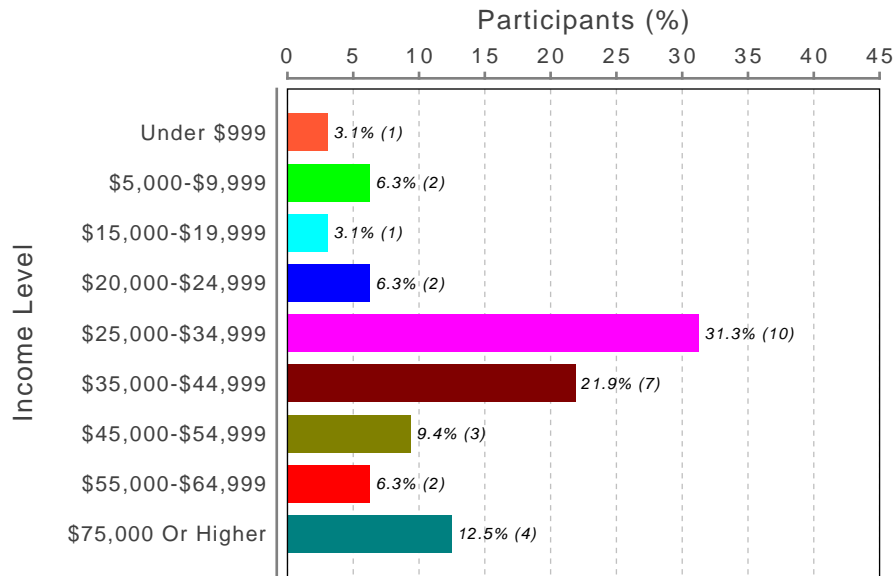

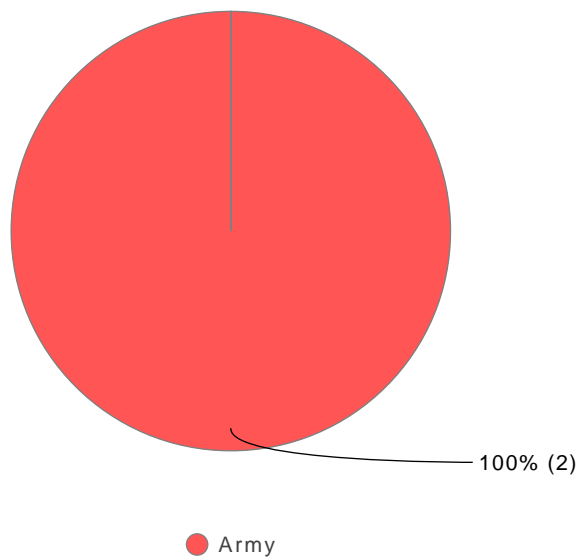
Income Level

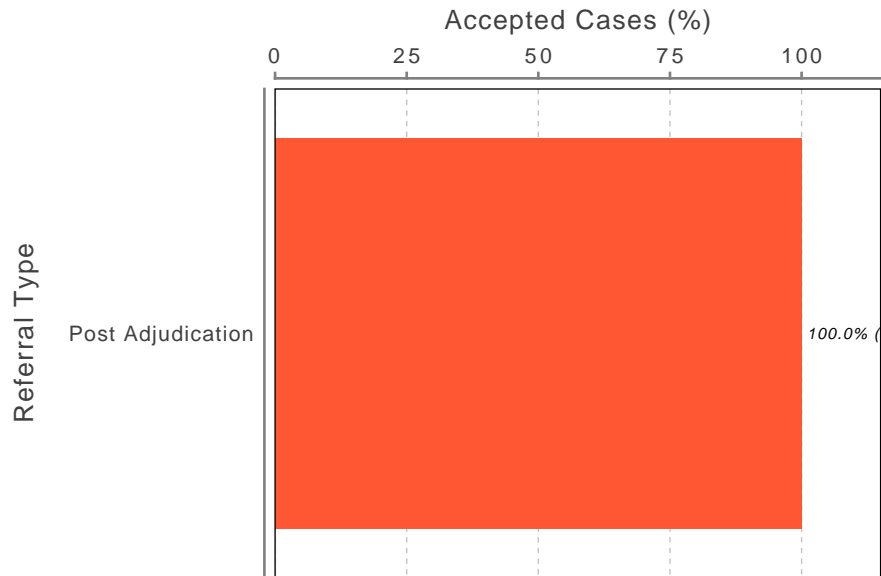

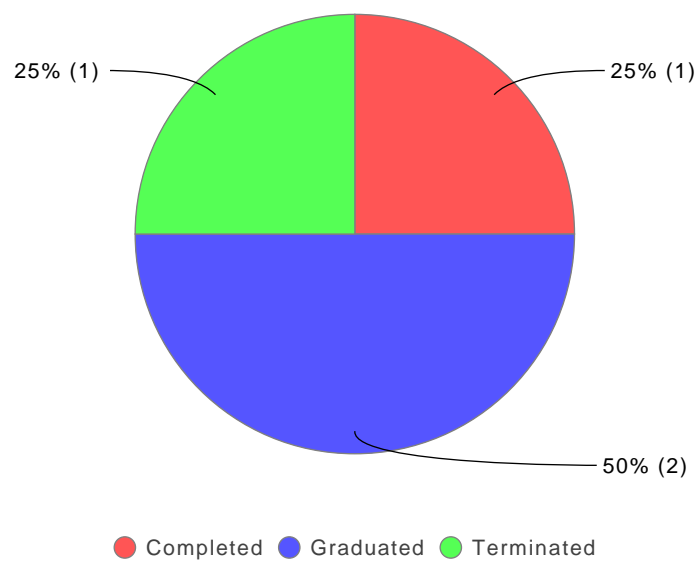
Accepted Cases by Referral Type

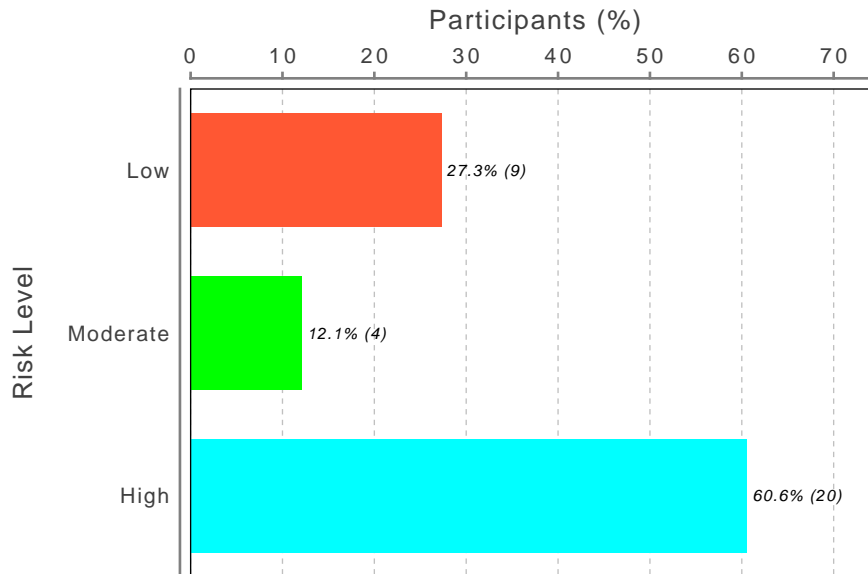

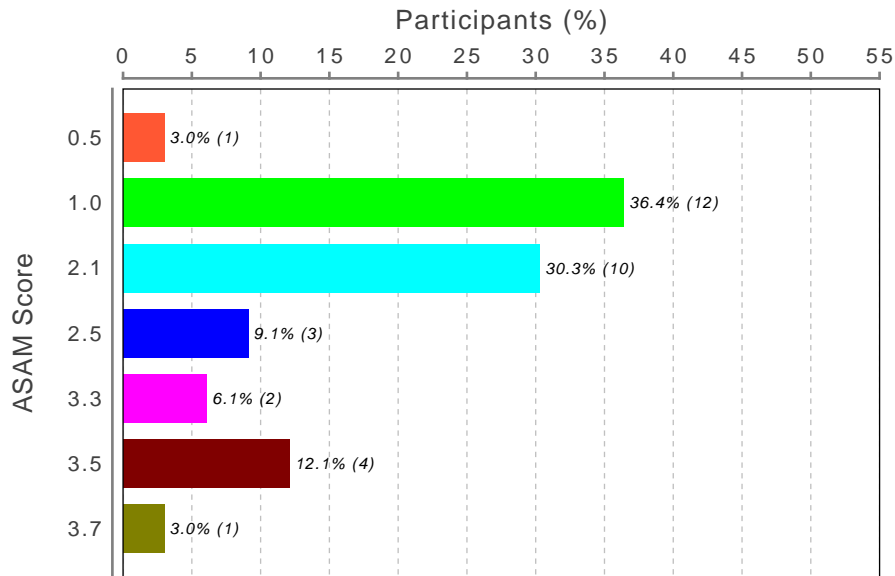

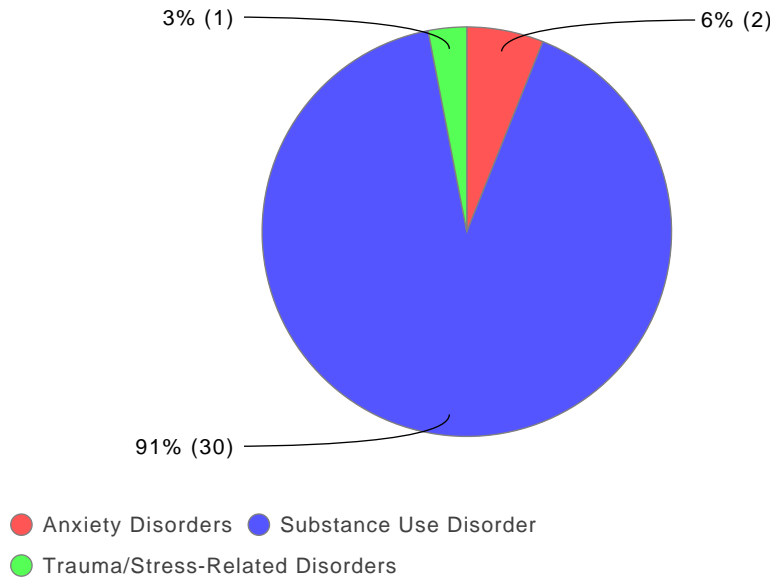

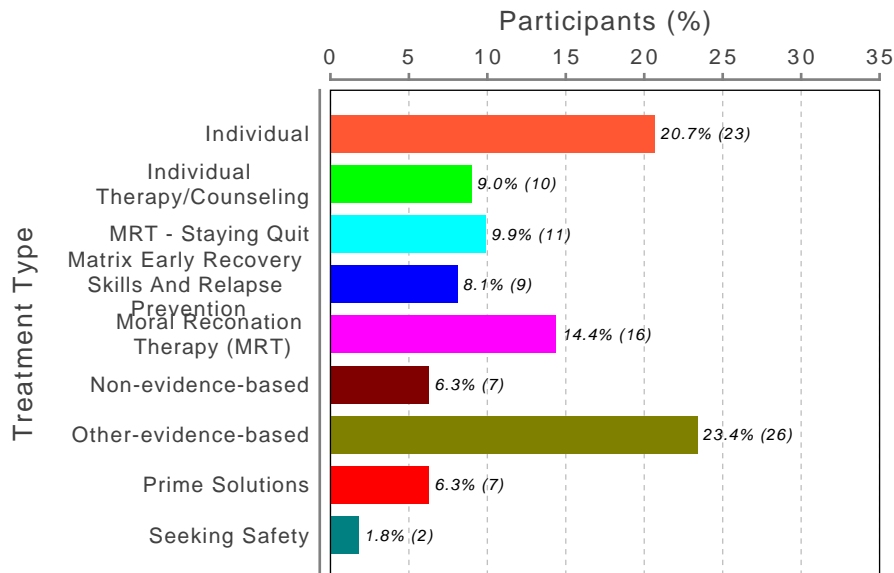
Diagnosis or Diagnostic Impression

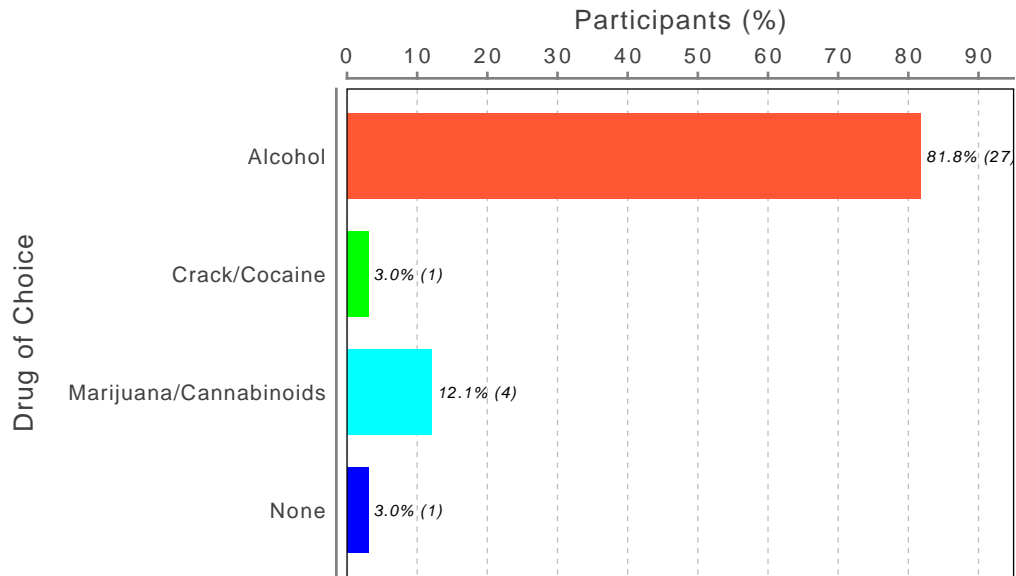

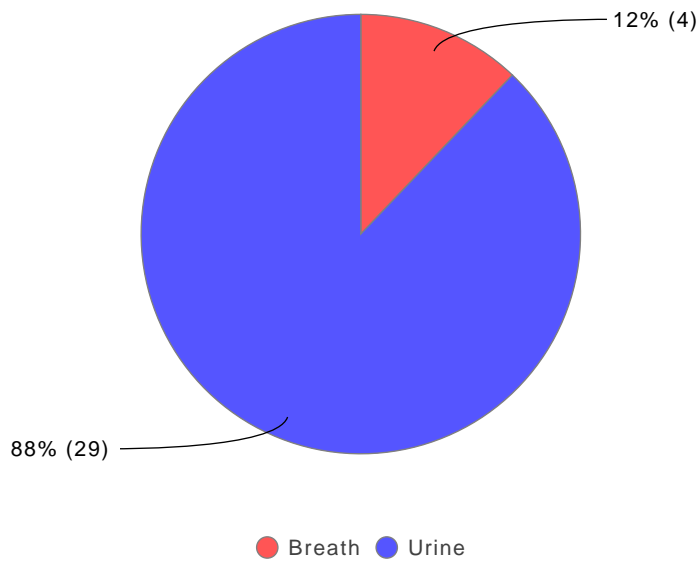
Primary Drug of Choice

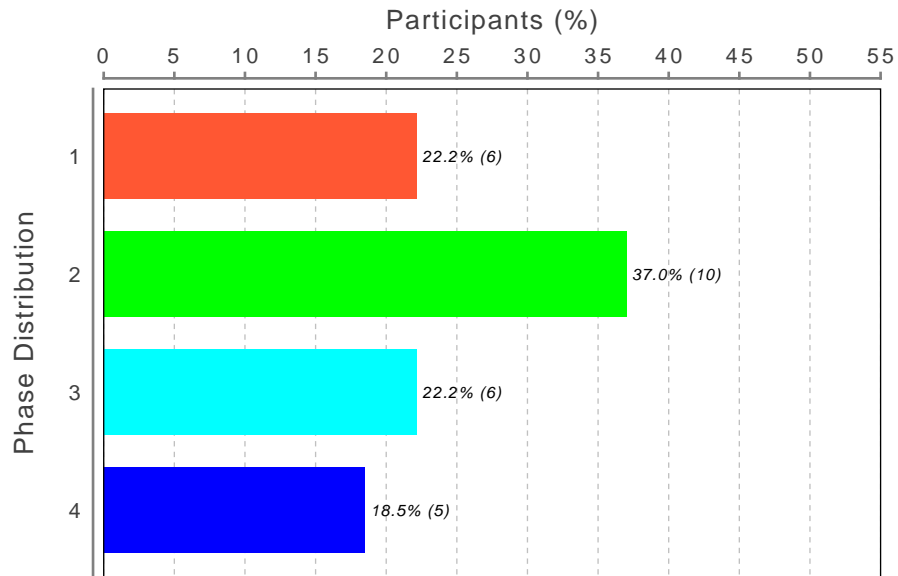

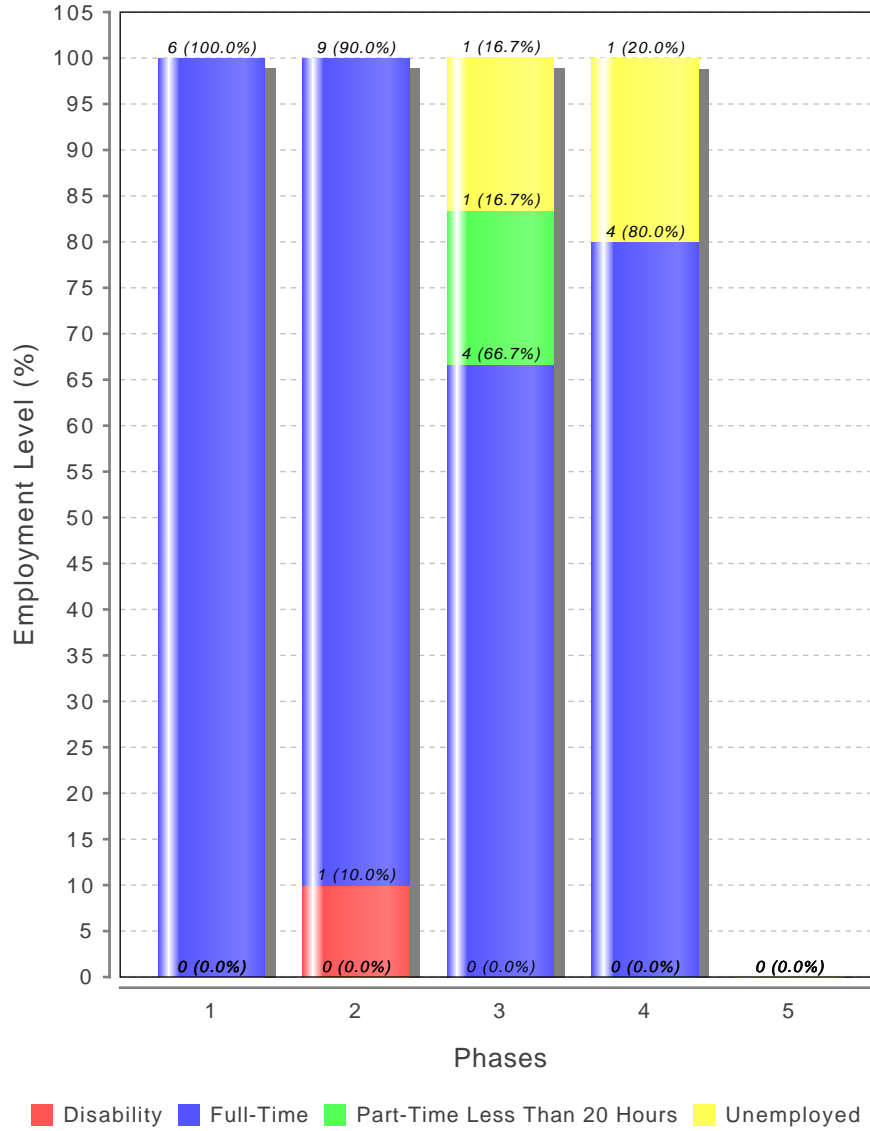

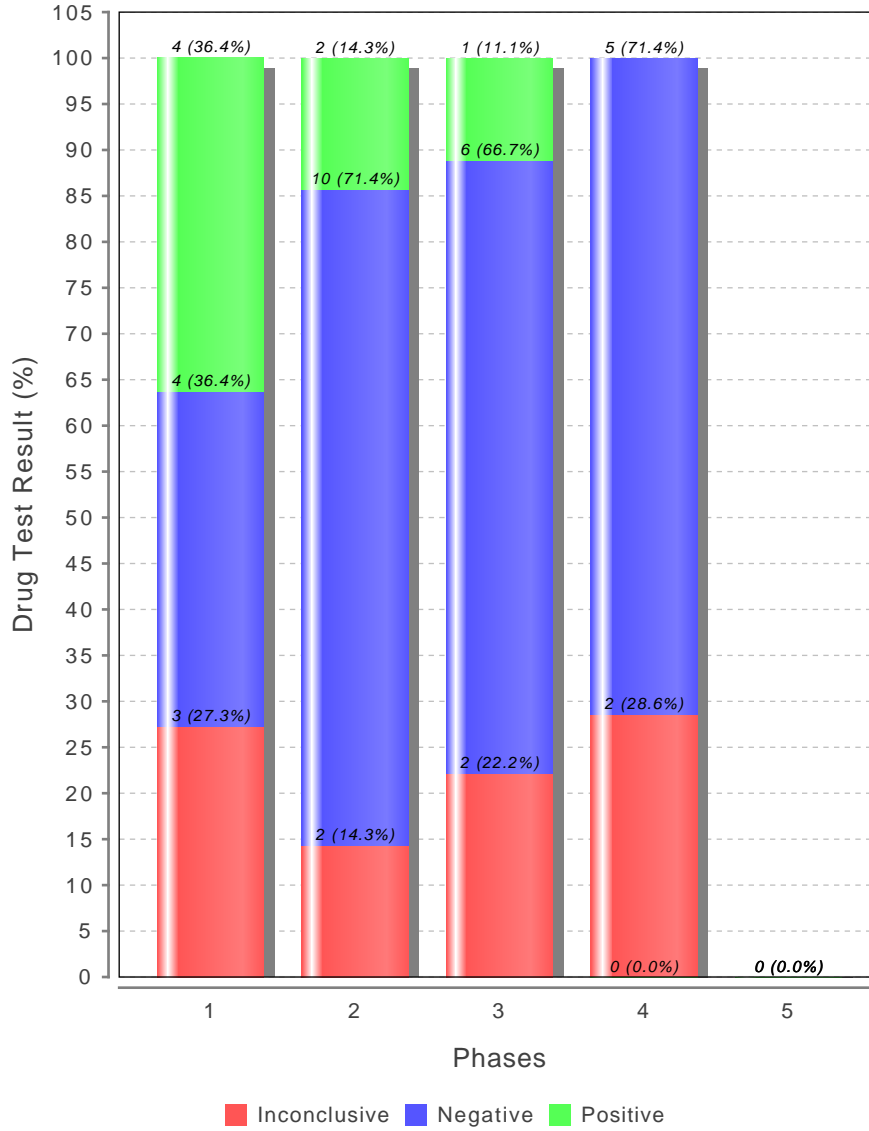

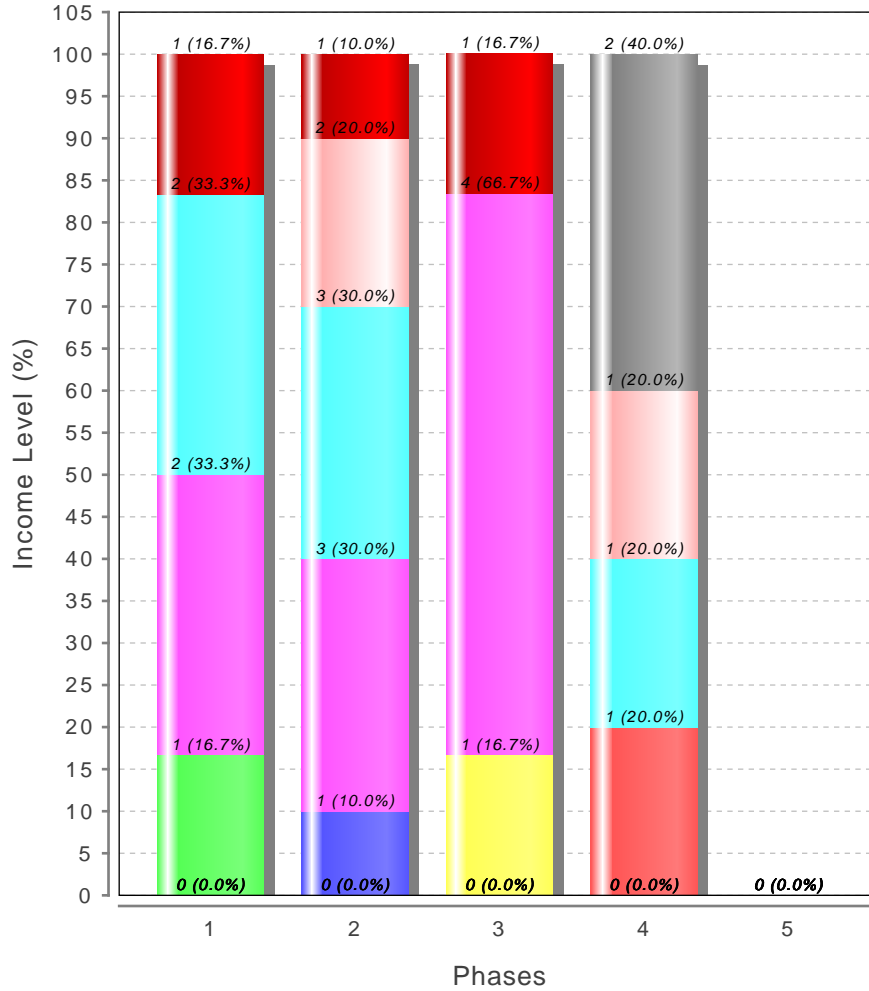
