Housing counseling: the bi-lingual staff helps families to stabilize their current living situation, providing services intended to help them achieve self-sufficiency. One major component of these services is the housing counseling program.

This program includes homebuyer education seminars, pre-purchase counseling, financial literacy, mortgage default/delinquency counseling, and foreclosure intervention and prevention.

Counseling: Services include outpatient mental health services for individuals, children, adolescents, couples, and families addressing issues such as depression, family and marital discord, behaviors due to consequences of addictions, anxiety, sibling conflicts, parent-child relationships, adolescent issues, grief, and loss. This includes specialized services in the areas of play-therapy, psycho-educational workshops, and parenting seminars.

Case management is a service to facilitate coordination, communications, and collaboration with clients, providers, ancillary services, and others in order to achieve goals and maximize positive client outcomes based on individual and family assessments.

Services also include ESL and civics classes to prep for citizenship tests, information and referral services, disaster response, benefits screening and application services, in-home parenting education, and veteran's support services.

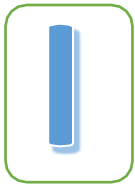
